The Austrian NCP received a specific instance in March 2022 but wasn't able to conclude the initial assessment in 2022. This was due to the fact that the specific instance is located in a highly sensitive environment (Belarus) and the NCP was included in a resource intensive process of negotiating the CSDDD.
